[data] forwarding	Data forwarding is the action of sharing IEDM data between two or more MIP gateways; thus. the IEDM data can span a National network. When a nation forwards data, it is not allowed to modify the IEDM data in any way.
[message] forwarding	Message [e-mail] may be manually forwarded to another mailbox if an intermediate [forwarding] addressee is identified, and the message to be forwarded is sent to the forwarding addressee first. The forwarding addressee will then manually select the message and forward the message to the final recipient addressee. This requires that the forwarding addressee's Mail Server can send/receive email to the final recipient's addressee SMTP Mail Server. Partial message forwarding/relaying can be accomplished manually by the forwarding/relaying addressee as requested/instructed by the sending addressee.
